

2011 WNY Bridal Show

Rules & Regulations

- 1) Metro Group, Inc. is not responsible for or liable in any way for any injury to person or property, loss or damage of any kind sustained by you, your employees or any other person by reason of fire, theft, water, accident, or negligence of management or any of its servants, agents or employees or any other cause what-so-ever, except in the cases of gross or sole negligence or willful misconduct. It is also understood that you will indemnify and hold harmless management from damages, loss, cost or expense, including costs of defense and reasonable attorney fees of any and all kind arising out of sole or contributing negligence of you, your employees, servants or agents or management or otherwise.
- 2) All exhibitors MUST provide a Certificate of Liability Insurance, at their own expense, naming the Metro Group, Inc. and the Event Center on the Fairgrounds in Hamburg, as additional insured.
- 3) Exhibitors will pay a fee of \$40 for each check returned by the bank.
- 4) Exhibitors may not assign or sublet any part of their exhibit space without written permission from Metro Group, Inc. Exhibitors may not exhibit or display notice of any other bridal-related show or event, including its participation in that event.
- 5) Booth assignments are made at the sole discretion of Metro Group, Inc. All placement requests will be considered. Metro Group, Inc. reserves the right to make space, location or floorplan changes.
- 6) Proper dress is required. Business casual attire is appropriate.
- 7) Booth breakdown and removal of materials before the closing of the event is prohibited. Violation may result in loss of opportunity to exhibit at future events and forfeit of database. Materials may NOT be loaded or unloaded through the glass doors at the Event Center.
- 8) Any projection of sound beyond the confines of the exhibitor's booth is prohibited. No objectionable lights or noises will be permitted in any exhibitor's booth. Metro Group, Inc. reserves the right to exclude or remove any objectionable exhibitor.
- 9) Any helium balloons brought in by the exhibitor must remain at the exhibitor's booth. Balloons may not be given to show attendees. Release of balloons in the Event Center is prohibited. Violators will be charged a removal fee.
- 10) All food items being sampled or sold must be submitted by the exhibitor to Metro Group, Inc. with the contract. Food vendors must obtain a health permit from the Erie County Department of Health (716) 858-7677. A copy of the health permit must be provided to Metro Group, Inc. no later than one week prior to the Show.
- 11) A database of information will be made available to all exhibitors within a few weeks after the show. The exhibitor agrees that this list is the property of Metro Group, Inc. and that the exhibitor will not sell, share or otherwise transfer any information contained in the list to any business or individual.
